This survey is accurate within +/- 4.2%, 19 times out of 20

Question 1: Mayor Tory recently announced that he wants to privatize garbage collection East of Yonge Street, including Scarborough.

This privatization would require firing approximately 500 city employees. A report released in the fall of 2015 confirmed that privatizing waste collection East of Yonge Street would not save the City money and that a mixed model of private and public service delivery protects taxpayers from higher costs.
